About two centuries earlier, the Puritan poet Anne Bradstreet also dealt with the topic of her belief and the flesh in her poem The Flesh and the Spirit (1678), but from quite a different perspective and with very different associations. According to Joseph McElrath and Allan P. Robb it is known from autobiographical material that Bradstreet started to read the Bible at the very early age of six (xvi). He also states that . . . her thorough familiarity with the Bible artfully manifests itself in virtually everything she wrote (xix). Therefore I argue that as a work of Puritan poetry Anne Bradstreet`s The Flesh and the Spirit is mainly inspired by biblical ideas. In my paper, I...
